## Powered by our dedicated colleagues, progress through the end of 2025 includes:



**\$35 million in grants** distributed by the Zoetis Foundation since 2021; achieved five-year grantmaking commitment.



Exceeded target of **100,000 trainings** delivered to farmers, veterinarians, para-veterinarians, distributors and lab technicians<sup>1</sup>.



**72,000 volunteer hours** reported by colleagues since 2021 with 20,700+ reported in 2025 alone; 104% of our target.



**85% of our global electricity** is now covered by renewable sources<sup>2</sup> and installed solar arrays at 8 of our facilities<sup>3</sup>.



**Received conditional licenses** for avian influenza vaccines in Canada and US and donated vaccines for endangered Hawaiian monk seals.



**29% decrease in scope 1 & 2 emissions** and completed 100+ carbon reduction projects since 2021 at our R&D and manufacturing sites<sup>4</sup>.



**Redesigning our product packaging** with sustainability in mind, including swapping plastic for paperboard where appropriate.
